

與南非海關簽訂AEO互認安排行動計劃

Signing of AEO Mutual Recognition Arrangement Action Plan with South African Revenue Service

繼今年4月與巴林海關簽署「認可經濟營運商」(AEO)互認安排及與沙特阿拉伯海關進行聯合認證工作後，香港海關進一步擴展AEO互認安排藍圖至南非。

於今年5月8日，海關助理關長（稅務及策略支援）許劍與南非稅務署認可經濟營運商主管Rae Vivier於深圳出席由世界海關組織及國家海關總署聯合主辦的第六屆全球「經認證的經營者」大會期間，在海關關長何珮珊及南非稅務署署長Edward Kieswetter見證下，簽署了AEO互認安排行動計劃，標誌着香港海關將互認安排網絡拓展至非洲邁出重要一步。

香港海關會繼續積極擴展AEO互認安排網絡，為企業締造更優質營商環境。

Hong Kong Customs and SARS signed the Action Plan for the AEO MRA, under the witness of the Commissioner of Customs and Excise and the Commissioner of SARS.

Following the conclusion of the Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) with Bahrain Customs and the joint validation visit conducted with Saudi Arabia Customs in April this year, Hong Kong Customs continued to expand the AEO MRA blueprints to South Africa.

On 8 May, the Assistant Commissioner (Excise and Strategic Support) of Customs and Excise, Mr Rudy Hui, and the Head of the AEO of the South African Revenue Service (SARS), Ms Rae Vivier, signed the Action Plan for the AEO MRA in Shenzhen during the 6th WCO Global AEO Conference co-hosted by the World Customs Organization and the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China, witnessed by the Commissioner of Customs and Excise, Ms Louise Ho, and the Commissioner of the SARS, Mr Edward Kieswetter. The signing of the Action Plan marked a significant step by Hong Kong Customs to extend the MRA network to Africa.

Hong Kong Customs will continue to take active steps to expand the AEO MRA network so as to promote a more favourable business environment.
