AEO Express - Inaugural Issue Brings you faster and updated AEO information

I am honored to witness the launching of the inaugural issue of "AEO Express".

Advocated by the World Customs Organization, the Customs and Excise Department (C&ED) formally launched the Hong Kong Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) Programme in April 2012. It is an open and voluntary certification regime with an aim to safeguard international supply chain security and facilitate global trade. Local companies which have met pre-determined security standards will be accredited as HKAEOs and recognized as trusted partners of the Hong Kong Customs. They can enjoy various benefits including reduced Customs inspection and prioritized Customs clearance. As of July 2021, there are 73 local companies being accredited as HKAEOs and they are also entitled to the facilitation offered by the 12 Customs authorities which have signed AEO mutual recognition arrangements with Hong Kong.

Through simple, swift and theme-based articles, "AEO Express" endeavors to bring you faster and updated information of the HKAO Programme as well as the development of AEO global network.
